### **MA ISCL**

- Typical workload approx. 30 CP/semester. ISCL Hauptseminare typically provide: 9 CP for 4 SWS + term paper/project, 6 CP for 2 SWS + term paper/project, 3 CP for 2 SWS + exam
- Maximally 15 CP (PO 2016, Module ISCL-MA-02, including courses required for admission) or 2 courses (old exam regulations) from the ISCL BA can be taken for MA credit:
  - 2/3 of BA credit if the standard course requirements are done.
  - Full credit if extra MA work is done beyond the regular course requirements.
- In total, at least 45 of 90 Hauptseminar CP for MA must be core Computational Linguistics.
  - Courses you want to take outside the SfS for a Hauptseminar requirement must be approved by the MA advisor Björn Rudzewitz when you **start** the course!
- At least three courses must be completed with **a term paper** before starting MA thesis.
  - Unless stricter guidelines are given by instructor, term papers must be completed at the latest by the end of the semester following the course, i.e., in second semester break after course.

## General notes:

- Enrollment in courses before semester starts:
  - For ISCL courses generally **no such registration is required**.
  - **but:** including the courses on your digital Campus timetable, permits you to be informed about any changes that could occur (change of class room, etc.) by e-mail.
  - For other SfS courses & courses taught elsewhere, typically you need to register online or with person teaching the course before semester starts.
- 1 CP ≈ 30 hours of work. So the time you spend in the lecture of a 2 SWS course during the semester amounts to around 1 CP. A course offering more CPs thus takes into account significant effort spent outside of class (homework, reading, projects, term papers,...).
