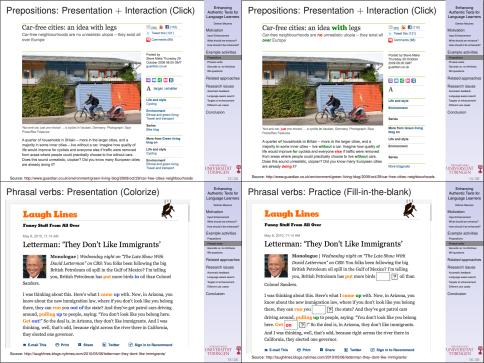

Related perspective Data-Driven Learning • One can view automatic input enhancement as an enrichment of Data-Driven Learning (DDL). • DDL is an "attempt to cut out the middleman [the teacher] as far as possible and to give the learner direct access to the data" (Boulton 2009, p. 82, citing Tim Johns) • WERTI: • learner stays in control and directly accesses data, • but NLP uses "teacher knowledge" about relevant language properties to make those more prominent to the learner. Research issues Supporting users in choosing web pages In principle, any user-selected web page is enhanced. Users typically use standard Internet search engines (Google) to obtain candidate pages on a topic of interest. This does not ensure sufficient representation and balance of occurrence of targets (questions, passives,).
